



**Group Arrangement:**

- 1: Jiuchi starts Doko Doko which continues right up to silent pause.
- 2: After count of 8 jiuchi beats all play Doko Doko quietly for another 8 beats.
- 3: Intro part is played between 2 groups using the emphasised beats.
- 4: When the last emphasised Doko'is played by all, everyone playes another 8 doko as a crescendo.
- 5: All play main pattern together once.
- 6: Group A play main pattern while Group B play 8 jiuchi and main pattern. (8 beat stagger)
- 7: Group A play a further 8 jiuchi to allow group B to catch up.
- 8: Group A play main pattern while Group B play Ki Ki'and pattern. (ki ki stagger).  
(Group B sync with Group A at Don Kon Don Kon'and  
both groups finish at the same time with an extra 'Don' on the end of the crescendo).
- 9: Count of silent 8 beats (jiuchi gives a click on 8th beat to cue everyone)
- 10: Pattern is repeated with Group B playing pattern while Group A starting with Ki Ki'  
(at this point jiuchi changes to Mitsu uchi 'Don Doko').
- 11: All finish pattern with a final 'Don' on the end of the crescendo.
- 12: Then all slowly raise their right bachi in unison. (as if it is floating up).
